All clubs who have received tour funding from CSB are required to submit a tour report 4 weeks after their return (if during term time) and 4 weeks after the start of term (if during holidays). This is to ensure that a club or society tour has fulfilled its aims and objectives as reported to CSB, to maintain an archive of club and society activities and to pass on to the IC Trust who supply a large proportion of the CSB Tours pot.

Things which should be included in a Tours Report

- Number of members attending (with breakdown of Full/Not Full members)
- Dates of tour
- What happened while on tour – i.e. activities, etc.
- Financial state of the tour
- Did it achieve the Aims and Objectives as laid out in the application.
- Were there any changes to the proposed A&O and Activities.
- Members' impressions of the tour
- Any major issues which arose while on tour
- How to improve for the future
- Photos!
