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### **Background**

I have been conducting a consultation into whether management groups feel that the groups they have are appropriate.

### **Points for consideration**

- Size of management groups. Should they be approximately the same size?  
Current range is from 6-60
- Representation of each management group. Each Management group chair represents their clubs. This means that some clubs are over and underrepresented due to the variance in management group size and membership.
- Work load the relative work load of each group
- Availability of new MG officers. Larger groups and active clubs provide good experience for a MG officer.
- The support provided through Faculty Unions.
- Impact on the student groups

### **Suggestions:**

- Dance groups in RCC would be more appropriate in A&E
- ICSMSU mountaineering and sub aqua should be merged with RCC groups
- Splitting ACC into BUCS competing and non-competing
- Combining RAG and CAG.
- Talk to groups that may consider moving management groups.

### **Management Group structure options**

- Create a new sub level between management groups and clubs
- Split management groups or recreate a set of management groups.
