Union Resolves (Actions)

Members of Community & Welfare Board will do a student survey to find out what kinds of community football matches are happening at Imperial. The International Officer will write a paper recommending how these initiatives are currently occurring, and how they might be joined up to facilitate community integration. The following areas will be investigated with the support of the Representation Team: Scoping out this kind of an event will bring parity between home and international students.

- Would Felix be able to include an Imperial-wide football league in their sports column? Would they be able to provide commentators?

- What would be a suitable venue?

- Would evening weekend time slots work for matches?
- What is an appropriate price range for tickets?

- What types of awards should be given out? Where will they be kept?
- Could departmental funds be utilised for this project?
